### WHAT TO WEAR

We ask that you wear the FAMM T-shirt that'll be given to you in the morning before the rally, and recommend that you wear shoes you can walk long distances in comfortably, and clothing that will keep you cool.

### GETTING TO HARRISBURG AND PARKING

The advocacy training and breakfast start at **7:30am** so please arrange enough time to drive, find parking, and go through security in the morning. Parking is located within a two-block radius of the State Capitol. ### SECURITY

Allow at least **15 minutes** to go through security at the Capitol. To speed up the security process, we advise that you do not bring any items that'd be considered a danger to yourself or others. Please be aware that Capitol police may confiscate any items that aren't allowed inside.

### What to bring

- Water in clear, plastic containers
- A good attitude and eagerness to meet other people!
- Your personal story of how you and your loved ones have been impacted by Pennsylvania's probation system.

### What **NOT** to bring

Please do not bring any items that would be considered a danger to yourself or others, or any of the following:

- Large or bulky bags or suitcases
- Signs, banners, or posters
- Aerosols
- Ammunition
